## IMMUNIZATION

### Policy Statement

It is the university’s policy that all students under the age of 26, regardless of program of study, part-time or full-time, degree or non-degree status, provide documentation of immunity against certain communicable diseases, required by DC law, by August 1<sup>st</sup> (for Fall enrollment) and January 1<sup>st</sup> (for Spring enrollment).

### Reason for Policy

To comply with DC law and promote a healthy university environment.

Students

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## Policy

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It is the university's policy that all students under the age of 26, regardless of program of study, part-time or full-time, degree or non-degree status, provide the documentation of immunity against certain communicable diseases, required by DC law, by August 1<sup>st</sup> (for Fall enrollment) and January 1<sup>st</sup> (for Spring enrollment). The specific communicable diseases for which students must show evidence of immunization are mandated by DC law. (DC Code §§ 38-501-508; DCMR Title 22, §§ 147-152).
